Hospice is special care for people who are terminally ill. The philosophy of Hospice is to help individuals experience peace in their final phase of living. Hospice also supports your family. This end of life care can meet physical, spiritual and emotional needs.

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Who is eligible for Hospice?

Anyone with an incurable illness and less than six months to live. Your doctor helps with this decision.

No one is denied Hospice for lack of funds.

What will Hospice cover?

Hospice covers all medical comfort care, including pain management ordered by your doctor. It will not cover curative treatments.
