

LOCAL LAW No. 3

A local law providing for weighted voting by members of the board of supervisors of the County of Ontario.

Be it enacted by the board of supervisors of the County of Ontario as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general, special or local law to the contrary, the supervisor from each town of the County of Ontario, the supervisor from each of the supervisory districts #1, #2, and #3 of the City of Geneva, and the supervisor elected by the electors of the first and fourth wards and by the electors of the second and third wards, of the City of Canandaigua shall be entitled to cast at the meetings of the board of supervisors of the County of Ontario one vote for each 200 inhabitants, or major fraction thereof, of the supervisor's constituency.

Section 2. (a) The number of votes that each supervisor will be entitled to cast at such meetings will be determined by the application of the population figures found by the federal census of 1960 as modified by subsequent special censuses.

(b) The assignment of votes to the individual supervisor of the board of supervisors shall be made on and at the first meeting of the board following the effective date provided in this local law.

(c) The assignment of votes under (b) above will be as follows:

Section 3. (a) The board of supervisors within one year from the effective date of this local law shall obtain a computerized determination of the number of votes each supervisor is entitled to cast based on the 1960 federal census as modified by any subsequent special censuses and such determination when received by the county shall thereupon control the number of votes each supervisor is entitled to cast.

(b) The board of supervisors within six months following the publication of an official countywide federal census shall obtain a computerized determination of the number of votes each supervisor is entitled to cast based on the findings of such countywide census and such determination when received by the county shall thereupon control the number of votes each supervisor is entitled to cast.

Section 4. This local law shall be subject to a mandatory referendum and shall be submitted for the approval of the electors of the County of Ontario at the general election to be held on November ~~4~~⁵ 1968.

Section 5. This local law shall become effective January 1, 19 ~~68~~⁶⁹.
