Local Law No. TWO of the year 19 78

as follows:

Section 1. Legislative intent. The Board of Supervisors of the County of Ontario, heretofore, and prior to January 1, 1978, announced its intent to increase salaries for management, elected, confidential, seasonal and part-time personnel, commencing January 1, 1978, although actual payment thereof would not commence until after a local law is finally adopted and filed in the office of the Secretary of State. It is the intent of this local law to assure the increase in annual salary for various county officers, elected or appointed for a definite term for the year 1978, as was announced heretofore, to take effect January 1, 1978.

Section 2. Commencing January 1, 1978, the annual salary of the incumbents in the following county offices and positions shall be the amount set forth opposite each such office or position, to wit:

County Administrator	\$ 26,403.00
Director of Real Property Tax Services	19,713.00
Commissioners of Election (2)	10,280.00 each
Director of Natural Disaster & Civil Defense & Fire & Energy Coordinator	14,954.00
Coroners (4)	5,156.00 each
Superintendent of Highways	25,071.00
Commissioner of Human Affairs	20,670.00

Section 3. An incumbent holding a position described in this local law at any time during the period from January 1, 1978 until the time when basic annual salaries are first paid pursuant to this local law

for such services in excess of the compensation actually received therefor, shall be entitled to a lump sum payment for the difference between the salary to which such incumbent was entitled for such service and the compensation actually received therefor. Such lump sum payment shall be made as soon as practicable.

Section 4. All local laws and resolutions of the Board of Supervisors of Ontario County, to the extent that the same are inconsistent with this local law, are hereby superseded by this local law.

Section 5. This local law is adopted subject to a permissive referendum, and the Clerk is directed to publish notice of the same as required by law.

Section 6. This local law shall become effective on the date when it is filed in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of New York and in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York.
