Local Law No. 8 of the year 19 78

A local law to provide for salary changes for various county officers, elected or appointed for definite terms, for the year 1979.

Be it enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the

County of Ontario, New York as follows:

Section 1. Legislative intent. The Board of Supervisors of the County of Ontario, hereby announces its intent to increase salaries for management, elected, confidential, seasonal and part-time personnel, commencing January 1, 1979, although actual payment thereof would not commence until after a local law is finally adopted and filed in the office of the Secretary of State. It is the intent of this local law to assure the increase in annual salary for various county officers, elected or appointed for a definite term for the year 1979, as is announced to take effect January 1, 1979.

Section 2. Commencing January 1, 1979, the annual salary of the incumbents in the following county offices and positions shall be the amount set forth opposite each such office or position, to wit:

Director of Real Property Tax Services	\$20,700.00
Commissioners of Election (2) at	10,900.00 ea.
County Attorney	18,986.00
Auditor and Financial Officer	24,719.00
Superintendent of Highways	26,350.00
Personnel Officer	21,900.00
Purchasing Agent	13,600.00
Commissioner of Social Services	27,000.00

Section 3. An incumbent holding a position described in this local law at any time during the period from January 1, 1979 until the time when basic annual salaries are first paid pursuant to this local law for such services in excess of the compensation actually received therefor, shall be entitled to a lump sum payment for the difference between the salary to which such incumbent was entitled for such service and the compensation actually received therefor. Such lump sum payment shall be made as soon as practicable.

Section 4. All local laws and resolutions of the Board of Supervisors of Ontario County, to the extent that the same are inconsistent with this local law, are hereby superseded by this local law.

Section 5. This local law is adopted subject to a permissive referendum, and the Clerk is directed to publish notice of the same as required by law.

Section 6. This local law shall become effective on the date when it is filed in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of New York and in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York.

5. (City local law concerning Charter revision proposed by petition.)

I hereby certify that the local law annexed hereto, designated as local law No. of 19 of the City of having been submitted to referendum pursuant to the provisions of § 36 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, and having received the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of such city voting thereon at the special election held on general 19 became operative.

6. (County local law concerning adoption of Charter.)

I hereby certify that the local law annexed hereto, designated as Local Law No. of 19 of the County of State of New York, having been submitted to the Electors at the General Election of November, 19, pursuant to subdivisions 5 and 7 of Section 33 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, and having received the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of the cities of said county as a unit and of a majority of the qualified electors of the towns of said county considered as a unit voting at said general election, became operative.
