A local law establishing Ontario County Health Facility Department.

Section 1. Legislative Intent. The Board of Supervisors of the County of Ontario, in its continuing effort to bring about the most efficient manner of providing services to the residents of this County, recognizes that the increasing complexities in providing health care and the operation of a health facility can be best administered as a separate department of County government.

Section 2. That, pursuant to the provisions of §10 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, there shall be an Ontario County Health Facility Department, the head of which shall be the Health Facility Administrator, who shall be responsible for the management and operation of the Ontario County Health Facility. Such Administrator shall be appointed by the Ontario County Board of Supervisors, serve for a term of three years, have the powers and duties necessary to carry out those functions of the department set forth herein and such other responsibilities as may from time to time be imposed by resolution of the Board of Supervisors or other legislative or regulatory mandates relating to the management and operation of the County Health Facility. The Administrator shall render an annual report of the department's activities to the County Administrator and oversee the preparation of an annual budget for the department. Within the appropriations made therefor, the Administrator shall appoint a Deputy Administrator who shall have all the powers of the Administrator, and act in the absence of the Administrator. Within the budgetary appropriations therefor, the Administrator shall appoint, supervise, discipline and remove

employees of the department and assign and reassign powers and duties to such employees.

Section 3. This local law shall become effective upon being filed in the office of the Secretary of State as prescribed by §27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
