A local law _____ amending Local Law No. 2 of 1982, entitled A Local Law Establishing _____
a Department of Buildings and Grounds

Section 1: Local Law No. 2 of 1982 is hereby amended to include a new Section 5,
and to read in its entirety as follows:

Section 1: Legislative Intent. The Board of Supervisors of the County of Ontario, in its continuing effort to bring about the most efficient manner of providing services to the residents of this county, recognizes that the increasingly difficult task of maintenance and operation of county grounds, buildings and other facilities can best be administered through a separate department of county government.

Section 2: Pursuant to the provisions of Section 10 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, the Ontario County Department of Buildings and Grounds is hereby created. Said department shall be under the supervision of the Director of County Facilities and Operations, who shall be appointed by the Ontario County Board of Supervisors for a term of three years. The Director of County Facilities and Operations shall be responsible for the management and operation of the Ontario County Department of Buildings and Grounds, and shall have the powers and duties necessary to carry out the functions of the department as set forth herein and such other responsibilities as may from time to time be imposed by resolution of the Board of Supervisors.

Section 3: The Director of County Facilities and Operations shall:

- (a) have charge of the necessary preservation, maintenance and repair of all buildings and grounds owned or leased by the county which are held, used or operated by the county for county purposes, except those highways, bridges, and other public ways which are under the jurisdiction of the Superintendent of Highways.
- (b) have charge and control of all employees connected with the care and maintenance of county-owned or leased buildings and grounds, except as otherwise provided in this section, may make such rules and regulations governing such employees as he shall deem proper, subject to the approval of the Board of Supervisors.

(c) perform such other duties and make such reports as may be required by the Board of Supervisors, including an annual report of the department's activities to the County Administrator, and preparation of an annual budget for the department.

Section 4: Within the appropriations made therefor, the director shall appoint a deputy director who shall exercise the powers and duties of the office in the event of a vacancy or the absence or inability of such director to perform the duties of the office.

Section 5: Pursuant to the powers vested in this Board of Supervisors by Municipal Home Rule Law Section 10(4)(d), the position of Director of County Facilities and Operations is hereby placed in the unclassified service of the civil service, and the position of Deputy Director of County Facilities and Operations is hereby placed in the exempt class of the civil service.

Section 6: This local law shall take effect immediately.

*Elective Chief Executive Officer means or includes the chief executive officer of a county elected on a county-wide basis or, if there be none, the chairman of the county legislative body, the mayor of a city or village or the supervisor of a town, where such officer is vested with power to approve or veto local laws or ordinances.

5. (City local law concerning Charter revision proposed by petition.)

I hereby certify that the local law annexed hereto, designated as local law No. of 19 of the City of having been submitted to referendum pursuant to the provisions of § 36 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, and having received the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of such city voting thereon at the special election held on general election held on 19 became operative.

6. (County local law concerning adoption of Charter.)

I hereby certify that the local law annexed hereto, designated as Local Law No. of 19 of the County of, State of New York, having been submitted to the Electors at the General Election of November, 19, pursuant to subdivisions 5 and 7 of Section 33 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, and having received the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of the cities of said county as a unit and of a majority of the qualified electors of the towns of said county considered as a unit voting at said general election, became operative.


