Local Law No. TWO of the year 19 84

A local law to Provide for Salary Changes for Various County Officers - Elected or Appointed for Definite Terms for the Year 1984.

Be it enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the (Name of Legislative Body) of the

County Ontario, New York
City of as follows:

SECTION 1. Commencing January 1, 1984, the annual salary of the incumbents in the following county offices and positions shall be the amount set forth opposite each such office or position, to wit:

Commissioner of Elections (2)	\$16,250
Commissioner of Human Affairs	31,750
Commissioner of Social Services	39,500
County Administrator	41,625
Deputy Commissioner of Social Services	28,000
Director, Agency for Real Property Tax Services	28,250
Director of County Facilities and Operations	28,000
Director of Natural Disaster and Civil Defense, Fire Coordinator and Energy Coordinator	23,000
Director of Planning	27,000
Economic Developer	28,125
Superintendent of Highways	32,750

SECTION 2. An incumbent holding a position described in this local law at any time during the period from January 1, 1984, until the time when basic annual salaries are first paid pursuant to this local law for such services in excess of the compensation actually received therefor, shall be entitled to a lump sum payment for the difference between the salary to which such incumbent was entitled for such service and the compensation actually received therefor. Such lump sum payment shall be made as soon as practicable.

SECTION 3. All local laws and resolutions of the Board of Supervisors of Ontario County, to the extent that the same are inconsistent with this local law, are hereby superseded by this local law.

SECTION 4. This local law is adopted subject to a permissive referendum, and the Clerk is directed to publish notice of the same as required by law.

SECTION 5. This local law shall become effective in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York.


