SECTION 1. Commencing January 1, 1985, the annual salary of the incumbents in the following county offices and positions shall be the amount set forth opposite each such office or position, to wit:

Commissioner of Social Services	42,000
County Attorney	47,375
Deputy Commissioner of Social Services	29,750

Health Facility Administrator	31,250
Paralegal Specialist (Res. #104, 1981)	18,875
Paralegal Specialist (Res. #481, 1983)	16,250

SECTION 2. An incumbent holding a position described in this local law at any time during the period from January 1, 1985, until the time when basic annual salaries are first paid pursuant to this local law for such services in excess of the compensation actually received therefor, shall be entitled to a lump sum payment for the difference between the salary to which such incumbent was entitled for such service and the compensation actually received therefor. Such lump sum payment shall be made as soon as practicable.

SECTION 3. All local laws and resolutions of the Board of Supervisors of Ontario County, to the extent that the same are inconsistent with this local law, are hereby superseded by this local law.

SECTION 4. This local law is adopted subject to a permissive referendum, and the Clerk is directed to publish notice of the same as required by law.

SECTION 5. This local law shall become effective in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York.


