Section 1: Local Law No. 4 of 1975, "A Local Law Establishing a Division of Human Affairs," is hereby amended by deleting the expression Human Affairs wherever it occurs, and inserting in its stead Human Services; and, in addition, all subsequent enactments of this Board of Supervisors are similarly amended.

Section 2: This Local Law shall take effect immediately.


