Section 1: Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision 6 of Section 215 of the County Law, real property owned by the County of Ontario in the Village of Victor now particularly described hereinafter or any portion thereof, may be sold, or leased from time to time, to private persons or corporations without advertising or competitive bidding upon such terms and conditions and in such manner as may be determined by resolution of the Board of Supervisors of Ontario County. Said parcel is more particularly described as follows:

ALL THAT TRACT OR PARCEL OF LAND, situate in the Village of Victor, Town of Victor, County of Ontario and State of New York, bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at a point in the center line of School Street, said point marking the south line of land now or formerly owned by the Lehigh Valley Railroad Company. Said point also being the beginning point in a deed from Hartman Material Handling Systems, Inc. to grantees herein as recorded in Ontario County Clerk's Office on August 18, 1986, at Liber 853 of Deeds, Page 447; thence N 42°19'00" W a distance of 1274.95 feet to the point and place of beginning of the parcel to be conveyed herein; thence

- (1) N 42°19'00" W a distance of 68.50 feet to a point, thence
- (2) S 07°15'53" W a distance of 52.00 feet to a point; thence
- (3) N 88°59'15" E a distance of 52.70 feet to the point and place of beginning.

Subject parcel containing approximately 1355.90 square feet, and being tax map number 016.17-2-60.

Section 2: This local law shall take effect 45 days after its adoption, or upon the approval of a majority of the qualified electors of the County at a general election to be held in not less than 60 days after the filing of a petition protesting the adoption hereof if such petition is filed according to law within the statutory period.
