A Local Law Amending Local Law No. 6-1986,
Establishing a Department of Employment and
Training

That Local Law No. 6-1986 of the County of Ontario entitled, "A Local Law Establishing a Department of Employment and Training" is hereby amended to read, in its entirety, as follows:

Section 1: Legislative Intent: The Board of Supervisors of the County of Ontario, in its continuing effort to bring about the most efficient manner of providing services to the residents of this County recognizes that the increasingly difficult task of coordinating and implementing a variety of employment and training programs can best be administered through a separate department of County government.

Section 2: Pursuant to the provisions of Section 10 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, the Ontario County Department of Employment and Training is hereby created. Said department shall be under the supervision of the Director of Employment and Training, who shall be appointed by the Ontario County Board of Supervisors for a term of two (2) years. The Director of Employment and Training shall be responsible for the management and operation of the Ontario County Department of Employment and Training, and shall have the powers and duties necessary to carry out the functions of the Department as set forth herein and such other responsibilities as may from time to time be imposed by resolution of the Board of Supervisors.

Section 3: The Director of Employment and Training, within the resources of the Department, shall:

- (a) Be the chief administrative official of the Department and be responsible for all programs, work, and projects undertaken within the Department.

(b) Have charge and control under general supervision of the Board of Supervisors of employees within the Department of Employment and Training. The Director shall have the power to appoint, suspend, discipline and remove all employees of the department and assign and reassign powers and duties to such employees. The Director shall manage the Department of Employment and Training in accordance with sound management principles, Board of Supervisor's policies, Civil Service Law, and other administrative policies and procedures.

(c) Perform such other duties and make such reports that may be required by the Board of Supervisors including an annual report of the Department's activities to the County Administrator and preparation of an annual budget for the Department.

Section 4: Within the appropriations made therefore, the Director shall appoint a Deputy Director who shall exercise the powers and duties of the Department in the event of a vacancy or in the absence or inability of such Director to perform the duties of this department.

Section 5: This Local Law shall take effect immediately.

5. (City local law concerning Charter revision proposed by petition.)
