SECTION 1: Legislative Intent

The Ontario County Management Compensation Plan, adopted on April 14, 1988, is a schedule providing higher rates of compensation through additional increments of salary based on time service, pursuant to County Law 201. This local law authorizes a cost of living increase for those officers appointed for a definite term for the year 1991, subject to the provisions of paragraph eight of subdivision two of section twenty-four of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

SECTION 2: Officers Appointed Prior to Management Compensation Plan

The Management Compensation Plan, established by Resolution 284-88 and as amended thereafter, shall apply to the following positions and incumbents thereof, all of whom commenced upon their present terms of office prior to April 14, 1988, for the year 1991:

Commissioner of Social Services
Deputy Commissioner of Social Services

SECTION 3: Cost of Living, 1991

The salary ranges established by the Management Compensation Plan shall, in accordance with its terms, be increased by 5-1/2% above the 1990 ranges for the year 1991, and the compensation of those county officers appointed for definite terms for the year 1991 shall thereby increase in accordance with the terms of Resolution 284-88, as amended.

SECTION 4: An incumbent holding a position described in this local law at any time during the period from January 1, 1991, until the time when basic annual salaries are first paid pursuant to this local law for such services in excess of the compensation actually received therefor, shall be entitled to a lump sum payment for the difference between the salary to which such incumbent was entitled for such service and the compensation actually received therefor. Such lump sum payment shall be made as soon as practicable.

SECTION 5: All local laws and resolutions of the Board of Supervisors of Ontario County, to the extent that the same are inconsistent with this local law, are hereby superseded by this local law.

SECTION 6: This local law is adopted subject to a permissive referendum, and the Clerk is directed to publish notice of the same as required by law.

SECTION 7: This local law shall become effective in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York.
