SECTION 1: LEGISLATIVE INTENT:

Local Law 2 of 1974 prohibits, among other things, the importation of human wastes in any form, treated or untreated, and other substances of similar nature or character into the County of Ontario. The City of Canandaigua has developed plans and specifications for the processing of sewage sludge into a material which may be beneficially reused in an environmentally acceptable manner, with the approval of the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation and the Environmental Protection Agency. This project will remove from the Ontario County landfill sewage sludge presently deposited therein by the City of Canandaigua. Responsible sizing of the city's project requires more sludge than the various treatment systems in the county generate, and therefor this Board of Supervisors determines that it is in the public interest to create a limited exception to Local Law 2 of 1974 for the sole purpose of enabling the reasonable development of the City of Canandaigua's beneficial reuse of sludge project.

SECTION 2: Section 2 of Local Law No. 2 of 1974 is hereby amended by inserting the caption "Exceptions" after the expression "Section 2.,"; redesignating the existing language of Section 2 as subsection "(a),"; and by inserting a new subsection to read as follows:

"(b) This local law shall not apply to the importation of sewage sludge required by the City of Canandaigua beneficial reuse of sludge project, provided that no such material shall be imported into Ontario County without the approval of the City of Canandaigua, and further provided that this exception is contingent upon the approval of the City of Canandaigua beneficial reuse of sludge project by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation and the Environmental Protection Agency.

SECTION 3: This local law shall take effect immediately.
