Local Law No. 4 of the year 2004

A local law Amending Local Law No. 5 of 1995 entitled "The Ontario County Sewer Use Law", (Insert Title) Canandaigua Lake County Sewer District and extensions thereof, and the Honeoye Lake County Consolidated Sewer District.

SECTION 1: Section 5.10 of Local Law No. 5 of 1995 is hereby amended to read as follows:

5.10 - Classes of permits; application fees

There shall be two (2) classes of building sewer permits: (a) for residential and commercial services, and (b) for service to establishments producing industrial wastes. In either case, the owner or his agent shall make application on a special form furnished by the District. The permit application shall be supplemented by any plans, specifications, or other information considered pertinent in the judgment of the Commissioner. A permit and inspection fee of **Two Hundred Dollars** (\$200.00) per connection to or disconnection from the District sewer line for residential, commercial or industrial building sewer permit shall be paid to the District at the time the application is filed. This fee covers up to two field inspection visits totaling two hours or less. Those permit applicants requiring additional service will be charged \$200.00 plus the actual cost of the additional services including labor, equipment and any administrative charges.

SECTION 2: All other provisions of Local Law No. 5 of 1995 are hereby continued.

SECTION 3: This Local Law shall take effect January 1, 2005.
