SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT

This Board of Supervisors hereby finds that the continuation of successful and meaningful negotiations with the certified or recognized bargaining units of Ontario County and Finger Lakes Community College employees may best be accomplished by enabling the Director of Human Resources to perform the duties of chief spokesperson on behalf of the county.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT

Section 3(a) of Local Law Four of 1993 is hereby amended as follows:

a) **Powers and Duties.** The Director shall

(3) ~~Serve as Division Manager for Human Resources, and as policy advisor to the County Administrator, Board of Supervisors, and all officers paid with county funds on matters of human resource development and management, and perform such other related duties and make such reports as may be required by the Board of Supervisors.~~

(4) Serve, at the discretion of the County Administrator, as chief spokesperson on behalf of the county in collective negotiations with certified or recognized bargaining units of Ontario County and Finger Lakes Community College employees, and perform such related duties as may be required by law, or by direction of the County Administrator, Personnel Committee, or Board of Supervisors.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This local law shall take effect immediately.
