Ontario County To Hold Two Solid Waste Management Workshops

Agenda: Plan for Solid Waste Management in Ontario County

Canandaigua, NY (Wednesday, June 8, 2010) — In August 2009, the Ontario County Board of Supervisors, Environmental Quality Committee, launched a planning process to examine solid waste and recycling services in Ontario County and to explore improvements to the County's facilities and services that the public will support. The anticipated outcome of this process is to reach consensus among residents and elected officials on a viable solid waste management system that serves the needs of residents, institutions, and businesses within Ontario County.
