Tracking and Monitoring People

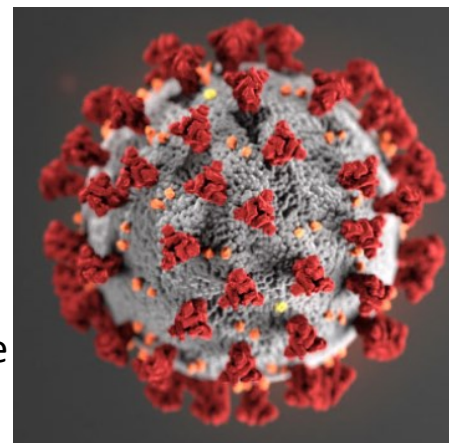
We are continuing to track and monitor residents that have traveled to a high risk country (China, Italy, Iran, Japan, South Korea) or have had contact with a confirmed case in an effort to immediately detect secondary cases and minimize the potential for ongoing, undetected, person-to-person transmission.

Reviewing and enhancing response plans

We continue to review and update our pandemic response plans.

Facilitating confirmatory testing, Isolation, quarantining and monitoring

We are ensuring that Ontario County residents experiencing symptoms are tested and isolated as soon as possible. We are quarantining and monitoring positive cases and contacts.
