Financial resources may be available to pursue training opportunities

Eligibility and suitability is determined on an individual basis

Individual Training Account (ITA)

- Short Term Training in a demand occupation for eligible job-seekers

Training leading to employment in these occupations may be considered for Workforce Innovation and Opportunity funding. Approval is based on an individual's suitability for training, labor market requirements, local policies and availability of funds.

- Tuition Assistance may be available up to \$5000.00 for nursing programs, \$4000.00 for CDL-A and up to \$3,000.00 in tuition assistance for all other programs.

Training provider and course must be on the Eligible Training Provider List to be considered for WIOA funding.

 - Do I understand exactly what is involved?
 - Will I get the support I need to successfully complete the program?
 - Will my training lead to better, full-time employment?
 - Are there abundant jobs available in this region?
 - Would I be eligible for additional financial aid?
 - Alternative funding source - apprenticeship programs
