

PERSONAL EMERGENCY RESPONSE SYSTEM

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By simply pushing a button, you can get emergency help 24 hours a day. A Personal Emergency Response System (PERS) consists of a base unit that is connected to your existing phone line and a small "button" unit. You wear the button as a necklace or bracelet.

What happens when I push the button?



The unit automatically dials the emergency response center for you. The operator will notify whoever is

on your emergency contact list. Your list may include family, friends, neighbors or even **911**.

How much does it cost?

The Office for the Aging provides PERS units to older adults who qualify. Call OFA to determine if you are eligible.

There are several companies offering Personal Emergency Response Systems in Ontario County on a monthly fee basis
